This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students reach the National Minimum Standards in Numeracy and Literacy.
- Ensure at least 40% of Year 5 students reach and maintain the Upper 2 Bands in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Improve the relative gain for Year 5 students from Year 3 in 60% or more areas in Numeracy and Literacy on NAPLAN.
- Ensure 100% of Prep Students are reading a Progress for Meaning (PM) 6 or above by the end of 2019.

Our initiatives include


- Continue to implement a whole school reading program that focuses on the explicit teaching of reading for all staff.
- Triangulate all student data (NAPLAN, A-E and diagnostic reading tests) to track students' knowledge and to provide support and / or extension.
