Every Queensland state school is reviewed by the Department of Education at least once every four years. School reviews provide important feedback to support schools in continuing to deliver guality education and improve learning outcomes for students.



Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Strengthen teacher understanding of the Australian Curriculum and unit planning processes to develop locally relevant and engaging curriculum units for students.
- Implement the agreed whole-school observation and feedback process for teachers and teacher aides, that is school-specific and in line with school priorities.
- Facilitate professional development and conversations with staff members to build shared understanding and consistent expectations of the management of student behaviour.
- Support staff to collaboratively engage in inquiry cycles to build shared ownership of the strategic direction of the school.
